

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF HUMBOLDT NO. 370

Bylaw 1-2022

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE PLACEMENT OF SNOW CLEARED FROM PRIVATE LANDS ON ROADS PURSUANT TO SECTION 8 OF *THE MUNICIPALITIES ACT, 2005*.

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Humboldt No. 370 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. This Bylaw shall be referred to as the Snow-piling Restriction Bylaw
2. In this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Humboldt No. 370
 - b) "road" means a "public highway" as defined by *The Municipalities Act, 2005*
 - c) "roadway" means the part of a public highway designed or intended for use by vehicles, including the shoulder.
 - d) "road allowance" means the area as defined by *The Municipalities Act, 2005*.
3. When clearing snow from private property, including but not limited to driveways, snow shall not be piled:
 - a) On the roadway
 - b) Anywhere within the road allowance, including the ditch, to a height higher than (1) foot below the lowest part of the roadway.
4. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties imposed by the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality and/or shall be liable for the cost incurred by the Municipality to relocate snow piled on the road or within the road allowance, including within the ditch. Current custom work rates for snow removal shall apply.
